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Dear Parents/ Caregivers

Our school conducts a Cooperative Religious Education Program that has been endorsed by the following religious groups: Assemblies of God Alliance, Apostolic, Anglican, Baptist, Christian Mission Alliance, Christian Outreach Centre, Churches of Christ, Catholic, Calvary Life Assemblies, Church of the Nazarene, Lutheran, Salvation Army, Seventh Day Adventist and Uniting.

Religious Education teachers are volunteers from a number of local churches who use an agreed program. This program is bible-based and ecumenical in nature and is produced by the Anglican Church. It is the program used by almost every State School in the Redlands. The Religious Education teachers comply with a Code of Ethics.

The Education (General Provisions) Act 1989 entitles accredited representatives of a religious denomination or society entitlement to provide religious instruction during school hours for a period not exceeding one hour per week. At Cleveland State School, lessons are held fortnightly for 30 minutes.

Based on the information provided on the student's enrolment form, students are placed in either the program of instruction provided by approved instructors or in an alternative activity.

After that initial placement, the student continues to be enrolled in the program or activity unless written parental notification is given to withdraw the student or the Religious Instruction program is no longer available.
